**Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2018**

A coach day trip from Norwich led by Dr Rob Knee of the Paston Heritage Society.

We will visit Paston church (including 3 tomb-chests, thought to be Paston, a brass to Erasmus Paston and two major Paston monuments) We will continue to Oxnead church where there are monuments to Sir Clement Paston and Lady Katherine Paston. We will then visit the gardens of Oxnead Hall, by kind permission of the owners. The Hall was originally built in 1580, with a 16<sup>th</sup> C range surviving.

Included lunch will be at Hill House, Happisburgh (selection of sandwiches, cake and tea/coffee, reserved tables)

In the afternoon, we will visit Caister Castle, built in 1432, by Sir John Fastolff, who left it to Sir John Paston.
