Coach from Norwich, travelling first to Layer Marney Tower in Essex. The tower is a Grade I listed Tudor gatehouse built in 1520. It is privately owned and lived in by the owners, one of whom will take us on a private tour, geared to us, and including parts of the tower not open to the public. The airfield opened in 1916 for the Royal Flying Corps and closed in 1919, when it reverted to being a farm and the buildings were put to agricultural use. Many of the buildings survive and are Grade II* listed. We will be given an introductory talk by the CEO of the trust, historian Ian Flint and then a tour of the airfield.
